ENGINE—Harley-Davidson does it again. Another engine that's short on frills and trinkets but long on output, endurance and economy. Notice the new ignition lock and diaphragm gas valve.

2 SHOCKS — Stronger shock mounts and longer rear fork add poise to what is already one of the best scramblers in the lightweight class.


3 STYLING — New Sprint-type grips and ball-end hand levers join a new speedo that'll tell you things you'll find hard to believe. And right behind the re-styled tank is a new longer, larger seat.

SAFETY — In compliance with Federal safety standards, side reflectors have been incorporated into rear light housing and front fork.

TRANSMISSION — The constantmesh box is a foot-operated four speed that gives you precise handling and smooth transitions. Nice in traffic, essential in scrambles. New foot pegs fold up and out of the way.
